

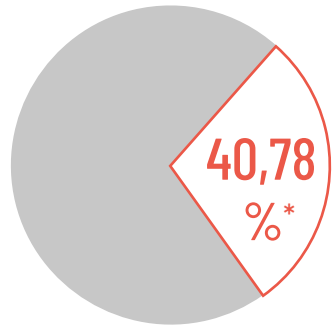
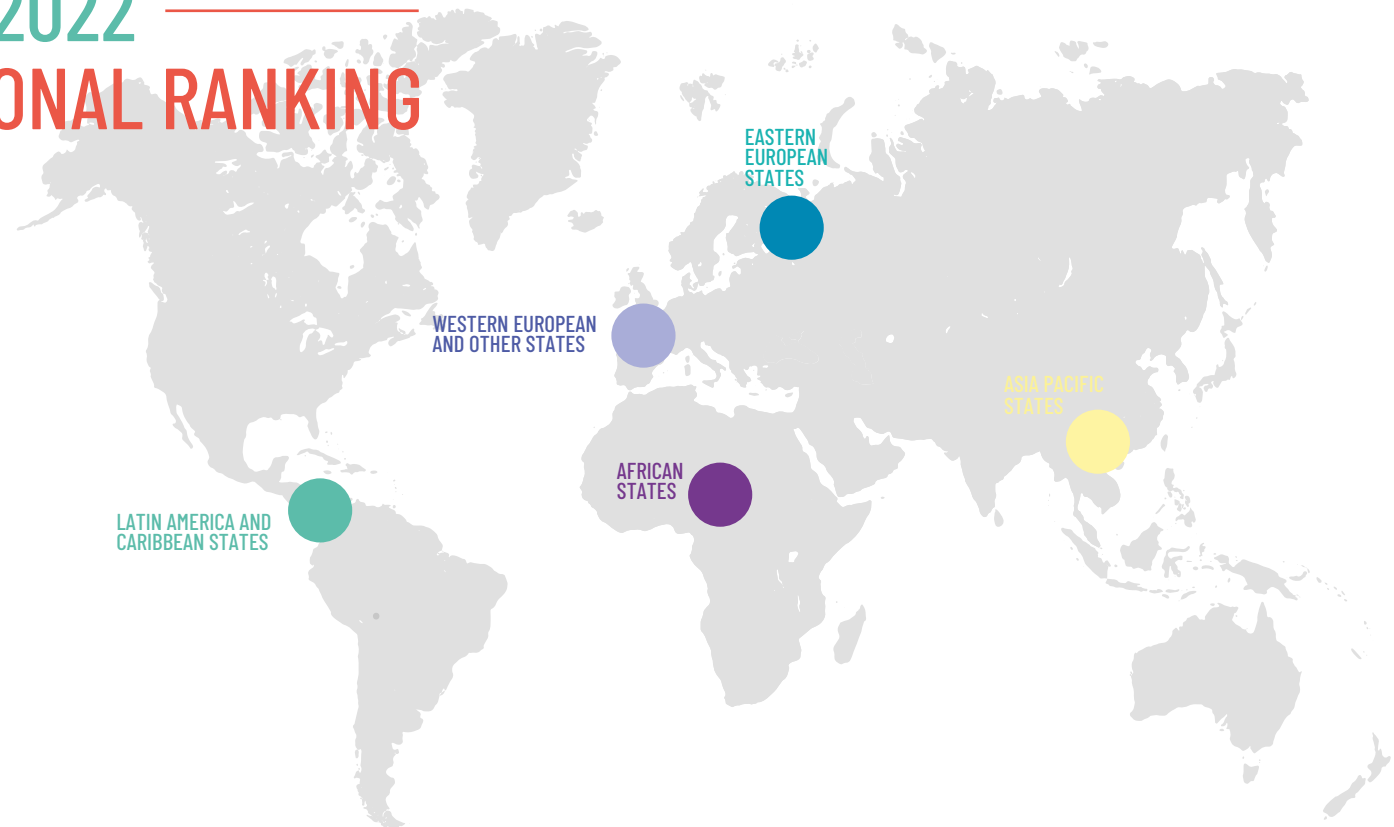

# RANKING 2022 ONU REGIONAL RANKING

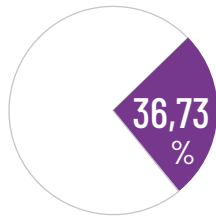

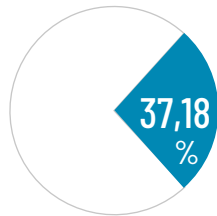

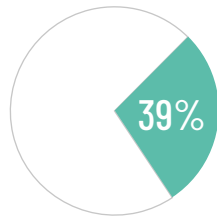

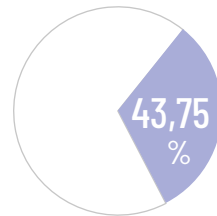

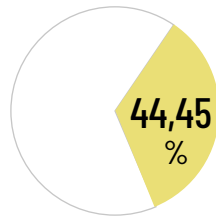

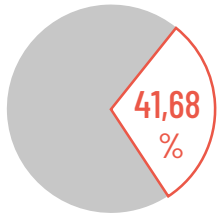
